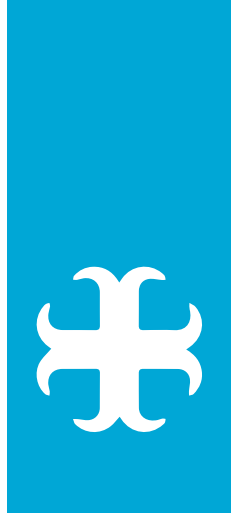
Reaching out for help can sometimes feel difficult, but we're here to help you access the support you need.
